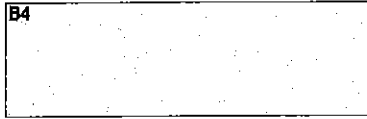

Elijah - #1514 9:50 am  
June 18, 1992

For the first 8 minutes of the 15 minute observation period, Elijah hung from the top of the cage with Miller (cagemate) clinging to his back. He appeared to be drowsy this morning at first. He climbed to the top of the cage and sat in the upper-left corner of the cage and watched me. He lowered himself down for a moment and motioned to Miller to come over. He did this by pointing at him and moving his arm over his head. Miller went to Elijah, and held on to his back. Elijah climbed to the top of the cage and scratched his nails on the cage top. Then Elijah left Miller and went to the other side of the cage (Miller stayed), but shortly returned to Miller. This time (when Miller was holding Elijah), he tried to loosen Miller's grip and get away again. He vocalized softly and Miller let go. I also noticed him using his enrichment device quite a bit and having a ball with it. At the very end of the observation period, Elijah was catching his feces and eating it.
